We are currently seeking a **Part Time Maintenance Mechanic**. The main function of the position is to ensure the safe and efficient operation and maintenance of the Hospital's buildings, systems, power plant, equipment and grounds. The incumbent is responsible for the day-to-day operation of the Hospital's preventative maintenance program, and also plays a significant role in the fire and disaster program, and Hospital security. The position works closely with staff in other departments, suppliers, contractors, and other maintenance mechanics, as is necessary.

Basic Requirements

- Certification in Facilities Maintenance or Maintenance Mechanics from a recognized College
- Three (3) years' experience in facility, equipment building systems, plant & HVAC maintenance and preventative maintenance. Must have a valid driver's license.
- Previous experience in the maintenance field, including the operation and repair of building systems, equipment and grounds equipment.
- A demonstrated knowledge of preventative maintenance programs.
- A demonstrated knowledge of the use of tools and woodworking equipment, blueprint reading, and job and building specifications.
- A broad basic knowledge in several of the following areas: carpentry, painting, plumbing, electrical work, construction & HVAC.
- Good oral and written communication skills.
- A demonstrated ability to test water in the boiler systems and to maintain the proper chemical levels.

Preferred Qualifications

- Previous hospital experience in the maintenance field.
- Previous experience as a plumber, electrician, carpenter, painter, refrigeration technician, etc.
